



Māori Bridging Scholarships

FOR INTENDING POSTGRADUATE STUDENTS

Division of Humanities

The Division of Humanities at the University of Otago is offering a number of Bridging Scholarships for Māori students in 2012. These awards are designed to encourage graduating Māori students to proceed to Masters and Doctoral research.

THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- ~ will pay your fees (fees paid for maximum of 1 EFT per year) for Honours or Postgraduate Diploma (PGDip) year and
- ~ will grant a scholarship of \$10,000 per annum

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- 1) Māori Bridging scholarships are available to Māori students who are completing either the final year of an Honours degree, Postgraduate Diploma or equivalent. (For more details please contact Ana Rangi at the address below.)
- 2) Applicants must be New Zealand Residents.
- 3) Applicants must be enrolled for a degree programme taught in the Division of Humanities, and:
 - (a) In the case of a student who has completed a three-year Bachelor's degree, this will involve enrolling in a PGDip
 - (b) Must be enrolled full-time on campus to be eligible for the Scholarship.
