

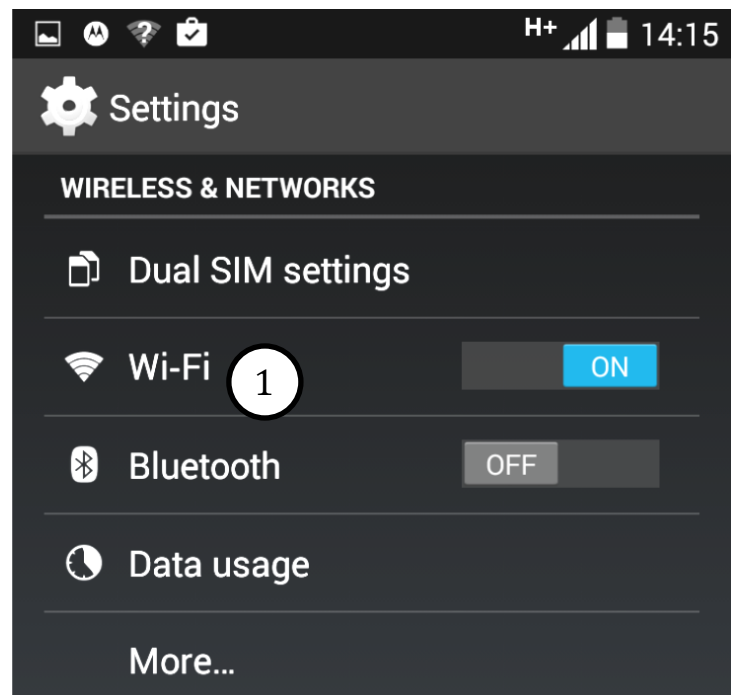
Connecting to UO_WIFI: Android



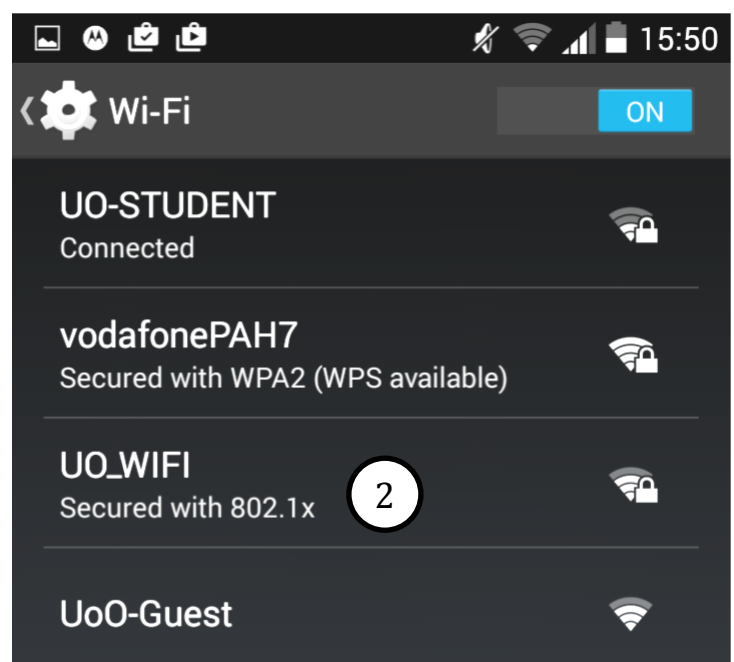
What is UO_WIFI?

The University of Otago network is being upgraded, and UO_WIFI is the name of the new wireless network. The older networks (e.g. UO-STUDENT, UO-STAFF) will remain while the new network is being rolled out. Your device will switch between them if it has connected in the past.

1. In the **Settings** menu, select **Wi-Fi**.

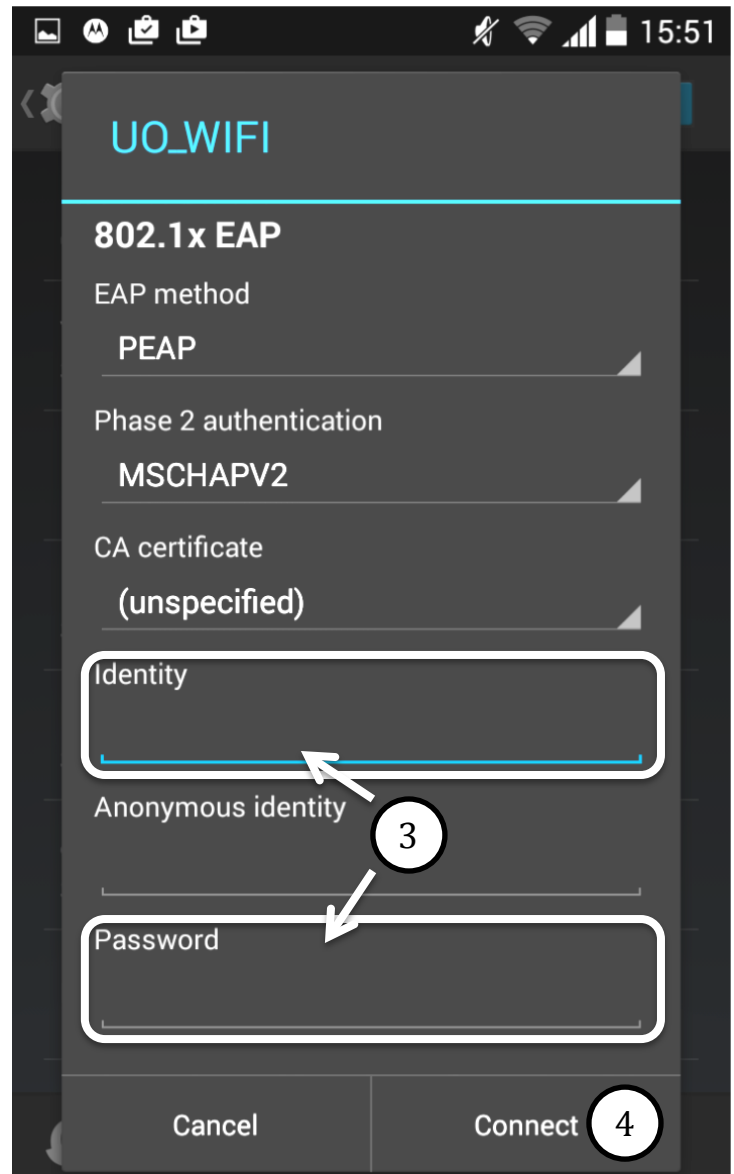


2. Check that the wireless is turned on, and then select the University network **UO_WIFI**.

3. Enter your University username and password in the **Identity and Password** fields. *Do not enter anything into Anonymous identity.*
4. Press **Connect**.



You are now connected.
