

## **The Radical Nonviolence in Aotearoa Hui**

### **20 – 22 November**

### **Puketeraki Marae, Karitane**

The Radical Nonviolence in Aotearoa Hui (meeting/gathering) aims to initiate dialogue and strategy building that will allow participants to share and extend their experience in promoting peace and building nonviolent communities.

Workshop facilitators from around the world with knowledge and experience of the history, theory and practice of nonviolence will run sessions covering:

- the colonial history of Aotearoa New Zealand
- nonviolent struggle
- the practice of nonviolence.

An emphasis will be put on not only gaining knowledge of nonviolence, but also skills in nonviolent practice. This will be coupled with discussions about what a nonviolent future would look like. We hope to bring a diverse group of interested parties, activists and academics, together to learn from one and other in our joint pursuit of a more just and peaceful world.

#### **Venue**

The Radical Nonviolence in Aotearoa Hui will run from the 20<sup>th</sup> until the 22<sup>nd</sup> of November and be held at Puketeraki Marae, Karitane (20 min North of Dunedin, see map).

#### **Cost**

Starting at a subsidised minimum figure, participants will pay attendance fees according to their financial ability via a sliding pay-scale. Payments above the minimum figure will go towards subsidising those of lesser financial ability. Registration costs are yet to be finalised but will simply cover the cost of meals and a \$20 per night accommodation fee.
