

Disability Information and Support Services offer the Imagine Beyond Scholarships which provide a great opportunity for secondary school students with an impairment or disability to participate in the week-long Hands-On at Otago programme. Each of the scholarships will cover flights, accommodation, meals and programme activities to a maximum of \$1,500.

All successful applicants will travel to Dunedin from 15–20 January 2023 and experience what it is like to be a student at the University of Otago. These opportunities aim to inspire and motivate secondary school students to develop their passion for learning.

Applications are open to students who will be in Year 12 or 13 in 2023, have an impairment, disability, medical condition or long-term injury, and have not previously attended Hands-On at Otago.

What do I need to do?

STEP 1	Fill out the application form online at: otago.ac.nz/hands-on-at-otago
STEP 2	Write an essay of approximately 500 words explaining why you would be a worthy recipient of one of these scholarships and what you would expect to gain from your experience at Hands-On at Otago.
STEP 3	Provide a letter of support from a teacher at your school. The letter of support must be written on your school's official letterhead paper.
