Economic evaluation of diagnostics and interventions in cardiovascular disease

Dr Praveen Thokala

This presentation will provide an overview of the economic evaluation of diagnostics and interventions in cardiovascular disease using two health technology assessment (HTA) projects as case studies. These include cost-effectiveness modelling of diagnostic strategies for suspected acute coronary syndrome (ACS) and telemonitoring for heart failure, performed for the NIHR (National Institute for Health Research) HTA programme in the UK.

Praveen Thokala is a health economic modeller at Health Economics and Decision Science (HEDS) in the School of Health and Related Research (SchARR) at the University of Sheffield. He has worked on several HTA projects and was involved in developing the Sheffield Type-1 Diabetes Policy model.
