## **Harnessing the Power of Networks**

Dr. Jim Thomas, Associate Professor of Epidemiology, University of North Carolina **Tuesday** 5<sup>th</sup> March 2019, 12.30-1.15pm

Communities typically have several organizations addressing a particular health outcome. How well do they work together? Do they see themselves as a collective network? Dr. Thomas will describe the use of organizational network analysis to improve HIV control in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia. He will include a beginner's introduction to network analysis.



Dr. Jim Thomas is an Associate Professor of Epidemiology at the University of North Carolina, the Director of MEASURE Evaluation, a project to strengthen health information systems in more than 50 developing countries, and a public health ethicist. He studies social forces that shape the distribution of disease in communities, public health ethics, and data ethics.
