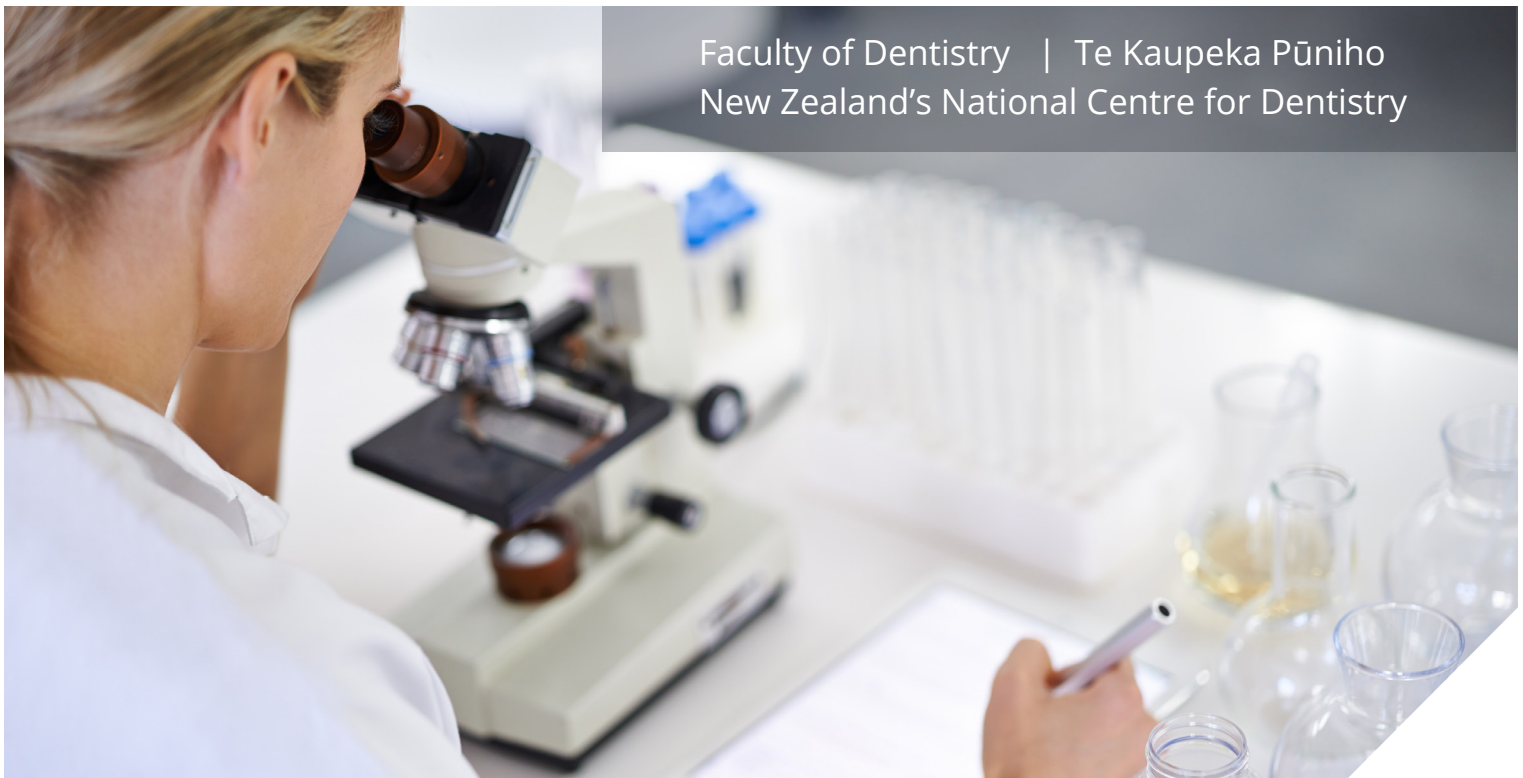
Our areas of research include:
