# **Available Scholarships**

### **Dunbar Research Scholarship**

This scholarship is open to graduates of the University of Otago, is tenable at the Dunedin School of Medicine, and is available to undertake research in relation to urinary, uterine or catarrhal disorders, or such other field of research as may be approved by the University. This scholarship would be particularly suited to a graduate of the Division of Health Sciences. This scholarship is for a period of 12-months, extendable to a second year providing that a satisfactory progress report is submitted with the second-year application.

#### **Emily Johnston Scholarship for Research in the Science and Art of Clinical Medicine**

This scholarship is open to medical graduates of any University in New Zealand who are Commonwealth citizens who hold a degree in medicine and have completed at least 10 months residence as a house surgeon in a New Zealand hospital with >100 beds. This scholarship is tenable in the Department of Medicine, for full-time research in the science and art of clinical medicine. This scholarship is for a period of 12-months only, but could be extended to a second year in very special circumstances.

#### Frances G Cotter Scholarship for Research in Medicine

This scholarship is open to medical graduates who are registered as medical practitioners with the Medical Council of New Zealand. Preference will be given to graduates of any University in New Zealand who will have completed the requirements for full registration. The scholarship is tenable at the University of Otago for the purpose of undertaking research in the Department of Medicine, Dunedin, or as part of a collaborative project involving another University department, with the active participation of a member of the senior staff of the Department of Medicine in Dunedin. This scholarship is for a period of 12-months only, but could be extended to a second year in very special circumstances.

#### Lady King Scholarship

This scholarship is open to medical graduates of the University of Otago or of other Universities approved by Council. The scholarship is tenable at the Dunedin School of Medicine and is available for the purpose of encouraging the study in New Zealand of preventative work in paediatrics and the well-being of mother and child in the antenatal, intranatal, and postnatal periods, and well-being of the child up to school age.
