Professor Diana Sarfati is the Head of the Department of Public Health and the Director of the Cancer and Chronic Conditions (C3) Research Group at the University of Otago Wellington. She recently led a Lancet Oncology series on cancer control in small island developing states. Aiono Prof Alec Ekeroma is the HOD of Obstetrics and Gynaecology University of Otago Wellington and his research interests are the gynaecological cancers. He will take up a new appointment as the Vice Chancellor of the National University of Samoa in February 2020.
