The life course epidemiology of child growth and obesity

Dr Laura Howe

Laura will present research findings on the influence of early childhood growth on later cardiovascular health, exploring the issue of whether infancy is a 'sensitive period' for the development of cardiovascular risk. She will also discuss her work looking at the determinants of child growth and obesity, ranging from socioeconomic factors to genetic variants.

This work utilises longitudinal data from cohort studies including the Avon Longitudinal Study of Parents and Children (ALSPAC) and the Pelotas 2004 cohort.

Laura Howe is a statistical epidemiologist at the University of Bristol, UK. Her main interest is in the life course epidemiology of obesity and cardiovascular disease, and she has expertise in statistical methods for modelling longitudinal data.
