Support through JumpSTART and Biological Physics (PHSI 191)

About this scholarship

The WHAI Physics Scholarship is co-ordinated by the Raukaha Health Workforce Development Unit's EQ programme at the University of Otago. The EQ WHAI Physics Scholarship is intended to support students who have had limited academic access or exposure to physics during secondary school.

This scholarship supports students undertaking JumpSTART Physics prior to enrolling in Biological Physics (PHSI 191) as part of the Health Sciences First Year (HSFY) programme.

WHAI Physics scholarships cover:

- Tuition fees for the University of Otago JumpSTART Physics course.
- Residential college accommodation for the duration of the JumpSTART course (3 weeks).
- Additional resources, tutorials and academic support for the PHSI 191 paper.

WHAI Physics Scholarship recipients will be required to attend a mihi whakatau in recognition of their award.

Raukaha/EQ staff will meet with individual recipients throughout the semester to provide support where needed. Recipients are expected to engage with the additional academic support provided as a condition of this scholarship.

About the JumpSTART Physics course

The purpose of this course is to provide students with the background knowledge and study skills necessary to confidently undertake the PHSI 191 Biological Physics paper at Otago. It is designed for students whose training in secondary school physics and mathematics is incomplete, having not taken Year 12 (NCEA Level 2) physics. Students undertaking this course will still need to meet the University's admission and entrance criteria in order to proceed to full credit study.

Eligibility criteria

Successful applicants must:

- Be a domestic student who attended a secondary school of Equity Index value (EQI)* 479 or greater for Years 11, 12 and 13 within the last five years.
- Show a commitment to pursue Health Sciences study and a career in health.
- Have met the entry requirements for the University of Otago JumpSTART Physics course.
- * EQI values range between 344–569; a higher EQI number indicates schools where students face greater socioeconomic barriers. EQI values are listed here or you can ask your school for confirmation

Application process

Students must submit a JumpSTART Physics application and enrol into the Health Sciences First Year (HSFY) to be considered for the scholarship.
