### **Introductory New Testament Greek Language and Exegesis 2**

### **Distance/Campus Course Description**

#### **Brief Introduction to the Paper**

This paper is designed to build on BIBS 131 and to develop further competence in New Testament Greek, including exegesis of passages from the Greek New Testament.

The paper works through the second half of a textbook, as well as translating and interpreting a section of John's Gospel.

The Textbook is: Duff, J. (2005). *The Elements of New Testament Greek*. Cambridge: Cambridge University Press.  
It is essential that students have this book.

#### **Assessment**

Two test, each worth 15%; Four assignments, each worth 5% and a three hour exam worth 50%

#### **Teaching schedule**

Campus: three lectures per week.

Distance: three lectures per week via Zoom. Students who are unable to join classes can download the videos and watch them at a later time.
