CHEM150 Concepts in Chemistry

Support through CHEM150 and The Chemical Basis of Biology and Human Health (CHEM191)



About this scholarship

The POPO Pacific Chemistry Scholarship is run through the Pacific Islands Research and Student Support Unit (PIRSSU) at the University of Otago. The scholarship supports Pacific students to prepare for the CHEM191 Chemical Basis of Biology and Human Health paper, as part of Health Sciences First Year (HSFY). Designed to support Pacific students interested in a career in health, the Pacific Opportunities Programmes at Otago (POPO) CHEM150 Scholarship provides access to the CHEM150 programme, as well as continuous support through the CHEM191 paper and HSFY.

POPO Pacific CHEM150 Scholarship covers:

- Tuition fees for the University of Otago CHEM150 programme.
- Residential college accommodation for the duration of the CHEM150 course (two weeks). The initial four weeks are completed via distance learning.
- Additional resources, tutorials and academic support throughout enrolment in CHEM191.

POPO Pacific CHEM150 Scholarship staff will meet with individual recipients at key points throughout the semester to provide support where needed. Recipients are expected to engage in additional CHEM191 academic support available as part of the scholarship.

About the CHEM150 course

The purpose of this course is to provide students with the background knowledge and study skills necessary to confidently undertake the CHEM191 Chemical Basis of Biology and Human Health paper at Otago. It is designed for students whose learning in secondary school chemistry is incomplete, having not taken Year 13 (NCEA Level 3) chemistry. Students undertaking this course will still need to meet the University's admission and entrance criteria in order to proceed to full credit study.

Criteria for the POPO Pacific Scholarship

Successful applicants must:

- Have Pacific Indigeneity.
- Show a commitment to pursue Health Sciences study and a career in health.
- Have met the entry requirements for the University of Otago CHEM150 course.

Application process

Students must enrol into the CHEM150 paper at Summer School and Health Sciences First Year (HSFY) to be considered for the scholarship.
