How to write a paper and get it into a good medical journal

Prof Lars Lindholm

This seminar will focus on the process of writing and submitting papers for publication, and how to maximise the chances of success in high quality medical and scientific journals. This is particularly relevant given the next PBRF exercise's greater focus on assessing the quality rather than quantity of publications.

Prof Lars Lindholm is trained in general medicine and public health. He is Professor and Chairman of Umeå University, Sweden; and Director of the Swedish Research School of General Practice in Sweden.



Professor Lindholm has extensive experience in publishing papers in leading international journals with over 230 original papers published on hypertension, CVD, diabetes, cancer, and public health issues, many in high ranking journals,. He is an adviser to the editors of the Lancet Group publications.
