Public Housing & Urban Regeneration: A Research Journey of Partnerships & Multidisciplinary Strands

Dr Crystal Olin | New Zealand Centre for Sustainable Cities | University of Otago, Wellington

In this seminar, Dr Crystal Olin (previously Filep) will speak to the five-year MBIE-funded research programme that she is Deputy Director of - Public Housing and Urban Regeneration: Maximising Wellbeing. The programme explores public housing providers' approaches to housing and urban regeneration projects. Its researchers are working in close partnership with seven public and community housing organisations to understand how different approaches to public housing affect human wellbeing. The overarching goal is to provide evidence which can be used to improve the wellbeing of people living in public housing, as well as their whānau and communities. The research team is composed of a range of collaborating partners and is headed by Distinguished Professor Philippa Howden-Chapman from the New Zealand Centre for Sustainable Cities which is based at the University of Otago in Wellington.
