2020 Submission Deadlines (to meet University-wide annual deadlines for Academic Proposals)

21 February (1)

LAST date for CUAP approval Round 1 for new 'programmes' for introduction (or deletion) in the following year and printed (or omitted) in the Guide to Enrolment:

- new qualifications
- new major subjects
- new minor subjects (where a major in the subject does not already exist)
- new endorsements
- programme deletions

(Form 1, Form 5)

[Note the full proposal for a 'programme' (i.e. qualification, or major, or endorsement, or minor) MUST have been preceded at least 4 months earlier by an Indicative Proposal (Form 1S).]

LAST date for introduction in the following year and printed in the Guide to Enrolment:

- new minor subject (where major in the subject already exists)
- programme regulation changes that affect the 'Structure of the Programme' clause and associated schedule changes (Form 1, Form 2)

LAST date for introduction in the following year and printed in the Guide to Enrolment:

- new papers and reinstatement of papers
- changes affecting pre-requisites, co-requisites, recommended preparation, recommended concurrent study, restriction, 'limited to' enrolment paper rules and Schedule C
- changes to titles or descriptions of papers
- changes to point value
- deletions of papers
- changes to teaching period or teaching mode of an existing papers

24 April (2)

LAST date for introduction in the following year and available on the website but NOT the Guide to Enrolment:

- new papers and reinstatement of papers

- changes affecting pre-requisites, co-requisites, recommended preparation, recommended concurrent study, restriction, 'limited to' enrolment paper rules and Schedule C
- changes to titles or descriptions of papers
- changes to point value
- deletions of papers and programmes
- changes to teaching period or teaching mode of an existing papers

(Form 5) LAST date for Programme Regulation changes that do not affect the papers in the clause 'Structure of the Programme' or associated schedules (regulation 18 September changes will be captured in time for the next year's Calendar) or require CUAP approval.
