### Effective Clinical Outcomes

#### Outcome 1

Coral receives appropriate treatment for her Chlamydia (Azithromycin 1g stat or Doxycycline 100mg bd for 7 days)

#### Outcome 2

Her husband is informed that he needs to be investigated

Her contact is informed that he needs to be Investigated.

Coral feels supported in her crisis

Coral has the benefits of condom use reinforced

### Safety issues

#### Safety 1

##### Error

Coral's husband is not treated for Chlamydia  
*For this error to be avoided the doctor should have completely achieved Outcome 2*

#### Safety 2

##### Error

The use of condoms is not reinforced  
*For this error to be avoided the doctor should have completely achieved Outcome 5*

##### Possible Adverse Outcome

Coral gets re-infected from him. She develops PID and has subsequent problems conceiving

##### Possible Adverse Outcome

Two years later Coral has another extra-marital sexual contact and does not use a Condom. She gets Chlamydia again and this results in PID
