Going South – the challenges of seafloor mapping under the ice

Early in 2021 Toitu Te Whenua / Land Information New Zealand, New Zealand's charting authority were contacted by Antarctica NZ about the requirements for a large scale chart in vicinity of Scott Base, Antarctica. The large scale chart was to support the base rebuild. Given the lack of hydrographic data in the area a modern hydrographic survey would be required. The area around Scott Base is a challenging area to survey with sea ice being present most of the year. This seminar discusses the challenges involved in a modern hydrographic survey in this part of the world.
