

Acceptance of Responsibility

Rental Rates

Student Rate - applicable to:

- Otago University current students
- Otago Polytechnic / Te Pūkenga current students
- Members (Staff, Youth, Community) of Unipol Recreation Centre

Public Rate - applicable to:

- Staff members of the University of Otago/ Otago Polytechnic (Te Pūkenga)
- All other members of the public

Rental Conditions

Identification

- Valid (current years) student identification/membership card must be presented at the time of the hire/booking.
- Members of the public must present a current driver's license or equivalent photo identification.

Payment

- Appropriate rental fee must be paid at the time of rental or booking.
- Members of the public pay twice the listed student rate.

Rental Period

- Rental hire is on a per-day basis. A one-day hire period is the time of pick up (that day) until closing the next day.
- If the hired equipment is returned after closing the day it is overdue 'another day(s)' may be charged.
- Exception is bike hires, where the bike must be returned before the close of the same day, unless by prior arrangement.

Bookings

- Prior bookings are not a necessity.
- Prior bookings are however advised to ensure equipment availability in busy rental periods.
- Payments must be made at the time of booking.
- May not be made more than 7 days in advance.

Conditions

The hirer must understand that they shall be using the equipment at their own risk and that Recreation Services is not liable for any injury or accident caused by the use or possession of this property.

Hirers may check out multiple items at one time but are limited to one type of equipment.

Equipment will be returned on time, in the same condition in which it was hired, clean & and undamaged.

- If equipment is returned late, the hirer shall pay for any extra day/s.
- If equipment is damaged or mislaid, the hirer will be required to meet all costs associated with the repair/replacement of the item(s). Nor will they initiate any repairs on the equipment themselves.
- A cleaning fee may be charged if the equipment is returned in an unacceptable condition.

Hire Agreement

- The hirer is responsible for the safekeeping of the equipment from collection until return.
- Hire is a privilege and therefore the equipment should be treated with care.
- I agree to take full responsibility for the hire and usage of the below equipment and will return it in the same state as it was hired by the agreed date. If not, I will pay the extra day(s) of hire.
- If damage occurs, I will notify Unipol Recreation Centre without initiation of repairs and will expect to be charged for any necessary repairs or replacement costs.

Bike Hire Agreement

When renting a bike from Recreation Services, the user will enter into the following agreement:

1. I agree that I am solely responsible for the care and safekeeping of all equipment hired for the duration of the rental period.
2. I will not ride or walk the bike on a beach or in the sea, or any other sand or salt water.
3. I am responsible for a tyre puncture, and I know there is a spare tube, tyre levers, and a pump provided with the bike.
4. If understood, the replacement costs of equipment are as follows:
 - a. Bike: \$1700
 - b. Bike Lock: \$40
 - c. Helmet: \$100
 - d. High Visibility Vest: \$30
 - e. Bike Bag (rear or front): \$50
 - f. Lights: \$45 each
 - g. Pump \$20
 - h. Spare tyre tube: \$10
 - i. Tyre levers: \$10
 - j. Seat: \$55
 - k. Chain: \$25
5. I understand that any damage, or misplacement, of any of the issued equipment will result in a charge to repair or replace relevant equipment, regardless of the cause.
6. Pick-up or replacement of a faulty bike is at the discretion of Unipol Recreation.
7. I have been provided with a bike lock, told the code of the bike lock, and agreed to lock the bike securely to prevent theft.
8. I understand that any claim in respect of damage and/or injury to other persons and/or property arising from the use of the Equipment is my responsibility, not the responsibility of Unipol Recreation and/or their employees.

9. I understand that New Zealand law requires the use of bicycle helmets, and I agree to always wear a helmet when I am using the bike, in a lawful safe manner.
10. I will follow the New Zealand Road Rules and have been allowed to ask questions about the New Zealand Road Rules.
11. I have been given a high visibility vest and understand wearing it is highly recommended for the safety of myself and others.
12. Cycling has inherent risks. I understand that Unipol Recreation has no control over these risks.
