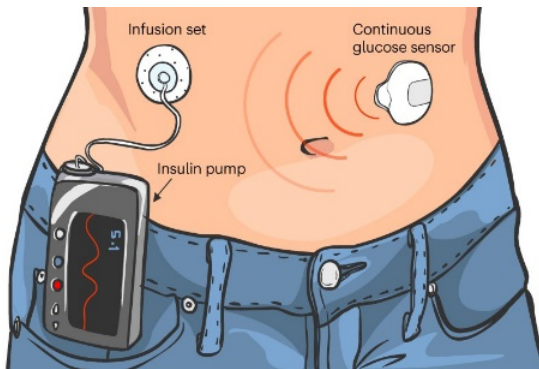

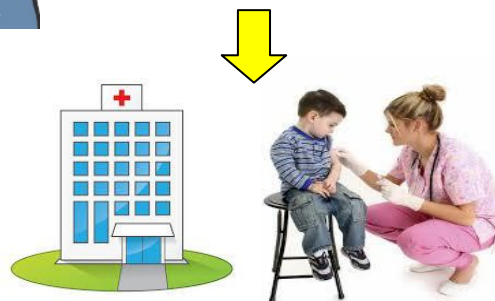

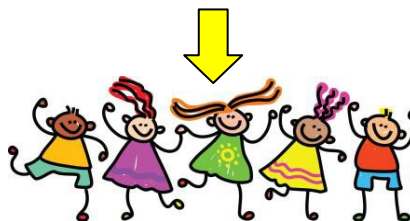


There is a new way of controlling your blood sugar and giving you insulin and we want to find out how well it works.

You wear a sensor on your arm, tummy or other area and an insulin pump on your tummy. The sensor tells the pump your blood sugar and the pump decides how much insulin to give you.
