
Bring faith and leadership together

with Otago's Master of Faith-based Leadership and Management (MFBLM) and Postgraduate Diploma in Faith-based Leadership and Management (PGDipFBLM)



These qualifications have been designed for professionals involved in the leadership and management of faith-based organisations who seek advanced professional education in both Theology and Business Administration to enhance their work.

The Post-Graduate Diploma consists of:

- Three 400-level Theology papers
- Four 400-level Business Administration papers

The Masters consists of the above seven papers and a 20,000 word Research Project.

All of the taught papers are available to Distance Learners.

Admission

The admission requirement for the Masters and the Postgraduate Diploma is a degree or equivalent three-year qualification in any subject area with satisfactory grades. If the student's prior qualifications do not include theological study, they are required to take one or more 300-level papers in Theology, in order to satisfy prerequisites.

General information

Because these qualifications are offered by distance learning they are suited for those who wish to study from home while in full-time or part-time employment.
