As a society we are increasingly recognising Te Ao Māori and Māori as the original inhabitants of Aotearoa New Zealand. Several statutory provisions require the recognition of Māori rights and interests in land. This involves defining their extents and recording them in the cadastre for all to see. This talk will cover surveys of Māori land, land to support Treaty settlements, and marine areas recognised in Customary Marine Title.
