



CHOOSING THE RIGHT SCHOLARSHIP TYPE FOR YOUR OTAGO MASTER'S DEGREE

For Research Master's Scholarships These degrees include a major thesis component. They may consist solely of a thesis, or also include some preliminary coursework prior to beginning [the thesis]. Apply prior to starting the thesis component of the degree; either at admission (for a thesis-only degree) or after completing preliminary coursework.	Scholarship depends on course option Candidates for these degree may choose a thesis option (in which case a Research Master's Scholarship may be applied for) or a research report/dissertation option (in which case a Coursework Master's Scholarship may be applied for). Apply at the point in the course where you must finally decide whether to pursue the thesis or research report/dissertation option. This may either be after an initial period of preliminary coursework or at admission.	For Coursework Master's Scholarships These degrees may include a research report or dissertation, but do not include a major thesis component. Apply at admission to the degree
