## **HOURLY RATES**

These rates† apply Monday-Friday.

Consult the Vessel Management Committee for a quote for weekend work.

†Rates are hourly and hours billed are based on crew hours including preparation and clean up time.

#### **EXPEDITION RATES**

These rates apply Monday-Sunday and is a daily charge.

Under the University's fatigue management policy, vessel crew are not permitted to work in excess of:

### 14 hours in a 24 hour period and no more than 80 hours in a 7 day period.

Please factor this in to your booking plans and book additional days if needed.

If research dictates that longer hours are required, this can be met by adding

additional crew at a rate of \$1000 per day per additional crew member.

Please contact the Vessel Management Committee if you are unfamiliar with the fatigue management policy and/or to discuss your requirements for your booking.

Vessel rates include fuel, skipper and one crew person.

Rates do not include equipment hire, food, laboratory supplies, communication charges, field station charges, overland transport or additional crew.

All rates are GST exclusive and subject to change.

If your field site is not local, a transit fee will be payable on the days the boat is making it's transit to your field site.

See the Transit Fees schedule for the regular transits undertaken by the Polaris.

The transit fee can be split between several contributing parties working at the same field site where only one transit is required.
