

Philip Neill Memorial Prize in Music

Established in 1943 the Prize is awarded annually for excellence in original composition.

Application is open to all past and present students of the universities of New Zealand. The prize is valued at \$1,500.

2024 topic and requirements:

Compose a duo or a trio for any combination of violin, cello and piano.

- You may adopt any theme you please with the work
- Electronics or prepared piano are not permitted
- The work should be between 8-15 minutes in duration
- You should include a programme note and any performance notes necessary
- Compositions MUST include a computer-set musical score and a MIDI recording
