In Round 2 2015, CUAP approved 'Recording and Production' as a major subject for the Bachelor of Music (MusB) and a subject for the MusB(Hons) (Dec 2015). However in early 2016, the Music Programme of the Department of Music, Theatre and Performing Arts restructured their offerings and changed the Bachelor of Music degree, removing the Majors and replacing them with optional endorsements. The department put the proposal to CUAP and it was approved in Round 1 2016. The Major subject 'Recording and Production' was replaced with the optional endorsement 'Studio Production'. The department prefers the term 'Studio Production' for its suite of music technology papers, and this same 'Studio Production' term - used for an area of specialisation within music - is also in place in the Master of Music degree (MMus) and the Doctor of Musical Arts (DMA).

Deleting the 'Recording and Repoduction' major from the MusB degree was overlooked when the change to the MusB(Hons) endorsements occurred – hence this form 5 has been prepared to notify CUAP of its formal deletion.
