Established in 2011 in memory of Emeritus Professor Richard Sutton, B.A, LL.M (Auck) LL.M (Harv) with financial support from his family, friends and former students.

Richard was a man of brilliance and of equal kindness. His contribution to the law was immense. This included his legal writing; his administration of legal education (he was a Professor within the Faculty from 1980 until 2004, and Dean from 1981 to 1985 and from 1998 to 1999); his involvement in law reform (he was a member of the Property Law and Equity Reform Committee and then, from 1992 to 1997, a New Zealand Law Commissioner); and his general contribution to the Legal Profession.

The Award is granted annually by the University Council, on the recommendation of the Dean of the Faculty of Law, to a student enrolled for the degree of Bachelor of Laws or Bachelor of Laws with Honours. Financial need as well as academic merit will be taken into account in granting the Award. In the case of a number of deserving candidates, the Award may be shared.
