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Auditions:

For Options 1 and 2 above, an audition is required. All students are advised to attend the audition in person if possible. Auditions are usually held in the **last week of September**.

Late applications will be considered, depending on teacher availability, but on-time application is recommended. Applicants who are unable to attend during the audition period are required to send a video recording for consideration. We accept video auditions filmed on camera or phone, or you can submit an existing performance (as long as it is recent) such as a school NCEA assessment.

If you are not attending an in-person audition, please send this form at the same time as you send us your video audition. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
