

## Professional competencies for Clinical Research Nurses/Midwives across 3 grade bands

Clinical Research Nurse/Midwife (CRN/M) positions are undertaken by registered nurses or midwives who have the appropriate level of clinical skills, research awareness, and professional specialisation within a health and/or clinical environment to support and contribute to academic teams primarily involved in clinical research. The registered nurse and midwives who work in CRN/M roles frequently make fieldwork/clinical research a career specialty and the three levels of professional competency recognise and support the development of speciality practice. The three levels of the CRN/M Professional competencies differentiate between the requirements of different CRN/M positions and will be used in conjunction with the General Staff Performance & Development Review competencies.
