Settlement Experiences of Kiribati Migrants Living in New Zealand Dr Mary Anne Thompson

This presentation examines the key factors influencing the settlement experiences of Kiribati migrants living in New Zealand. The findings from this doctoral research are set within the context of likely increased outward migration pressures from Kiribati to New Zealand, due to climate change and other anthropogenic impacts.



Mary Anne Thompson completed her PhD at the University of Otago in 2016. Prior to this, she was a senior public servant specialising in policy analysis and development. She also has experience as an applied researcher and an understanding of migration policy settings and the Pacific.
