Being registered for The Prevocational Obstetrics and Gynaecology Society of Australia and New Zealand (PVOGS)		1 point
Have completed any OBGY paper as a Certificate of Proficiency(COP)		4 points
Clinical Placement:	The candidate must have secured, for a minimum of 26 weeks, a hospital position in obstetrics and gynaecology in New Zealand.	5 points

## **Information for Candidates:**

The selection will be scored on the above criteria. Admissions to the programme will be offered in the following order:

- 1. Postgraduate Diploma in Obstetrics and Medical Gynaecology (PGDipOMG): Maximum 42 places
- 2. Postgraduate Certificate in Women's Health ( PGCertWHlth): Maximum 20 places, if Diploma full
