The primary supervisor of the successful applicant will also receive a NZ\$3,000 project seeding grant to cover initial research expenses.

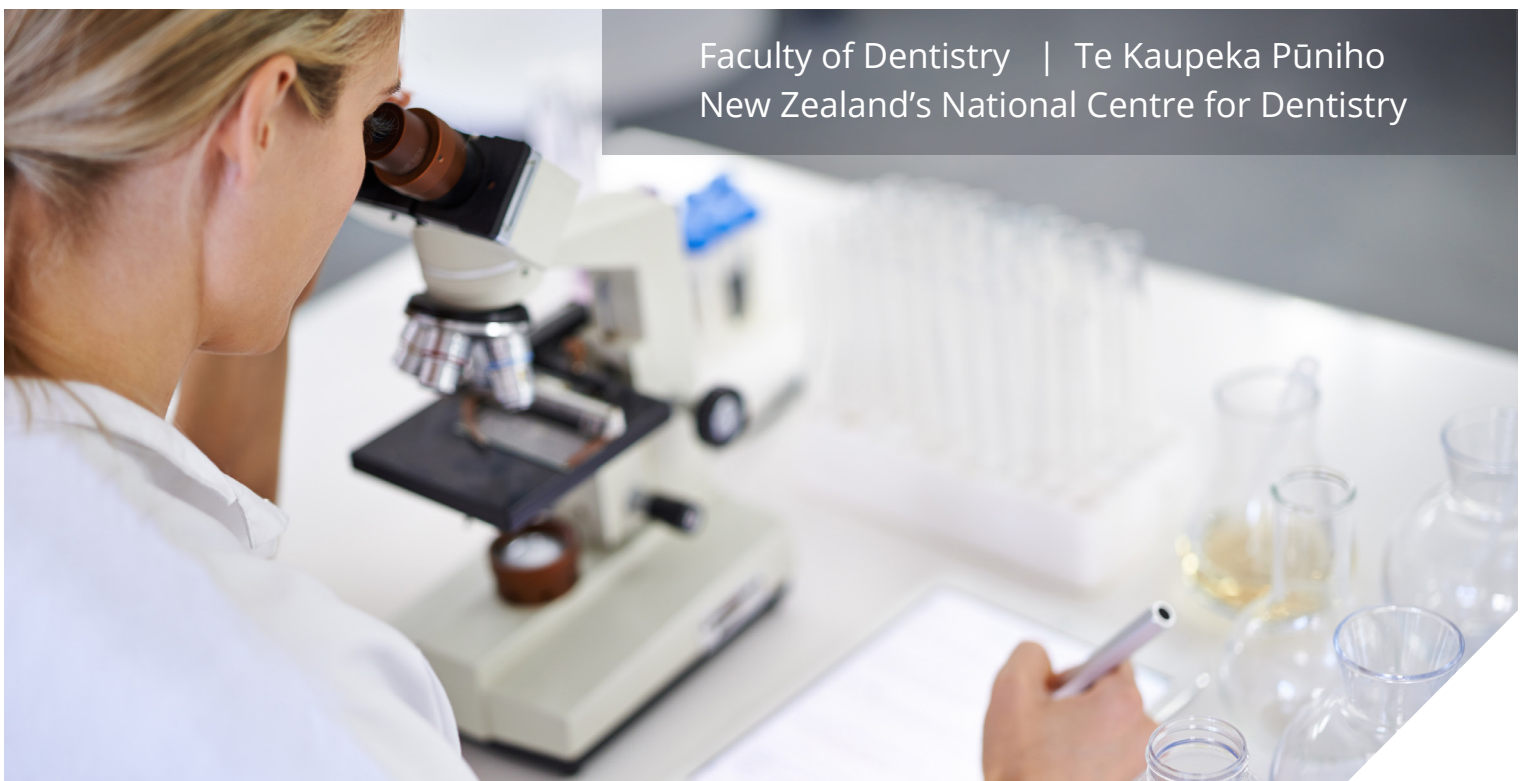
Our areas of research include:
