## Successes, challenges and opportunities for public health in New Zealand

Ashley Bloomfield, Director-General of Health

Dr Bloomfield qualified in medicine at the University of Auckland in 1990 and after several years of clinical work specialised in public health medicine. His particular area of professional interest is non-communicable disease prevention and control, and he spent 2011 at the World Health Organization in Geneva working on this topic at a global level.



Prior to commencing as Director-General, Dr Bloomfield was Chief Executive at the Hutt Valley District Health Board and has previously held a number of senior leadership roles within the Ministry of Health. From 2012–15 he was Director of Service Integration and Development and General Manager Population Health at Capital & Coast, Hutt and Wairarapa District Health Boards.
