Who wants to be a "clicker"-naire ?



What is it?

- It's a system that you can use to collect instant feedback from a group to any questions you ask.
- It can be anonymous and you can get an answer from the whole group simultaneously.
- It can be used with any size group, up to a full lecture theatre!

What can I do with it?

- Receive feedback from a class, so you can gauge how well they are understanding the content
- Run a paperless test
- Allow all students to participate in a lecture, in an anonymous way free from peer pressure
- Present in an interactive way

The receiving unit




A "clicker" for each respondent




Some questions

How does it work?




Pose a Question

- Ask a Question.
- You can embed a slideshow, run a document alongside, write on the whiteboard or just ask as you go.
- Click the START button.



Receive Responses

- Each clicker that has responded shows as a numbered block on the screen. Responders can check their answer has been received.
- The question number, a count of responses, and time remaining to answer are shown.
- Click STOP to end the question.



Show the answers

- A histogram of the responses is automatically shown.
- You can indicate which was the correct response for instant feedback
- Click START to move to the next question
