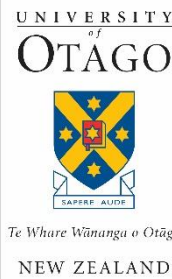

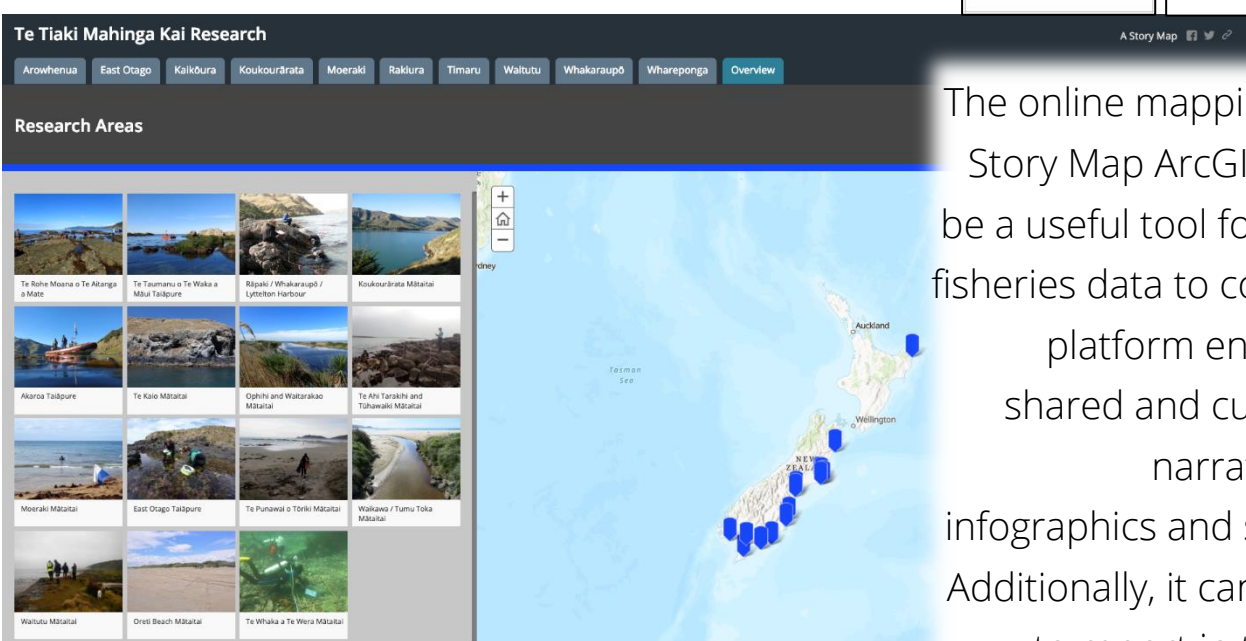
Using Esri Story Map ArcGIS to communicate local fishery data
