Preview controls



Preview screens work independently from each other and the projectors. What you choose to display in preview will only affect that preview.

Touch within the preview window for options:



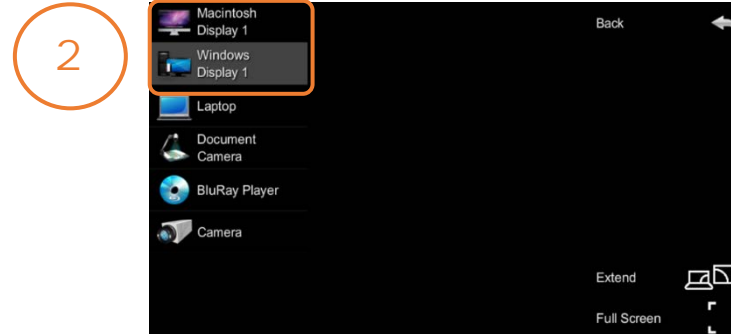
Extended mode

This allows for the Mac and PC to preview or project a second display

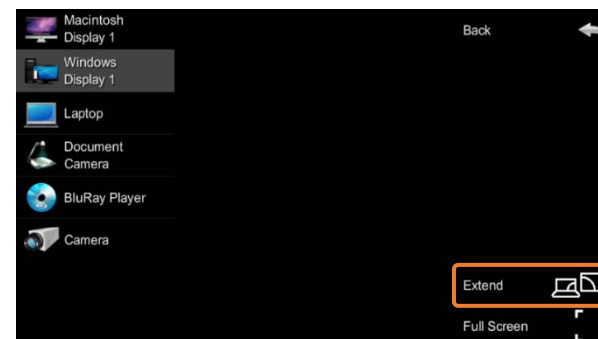
1. Touch within either or both preview windows for options.



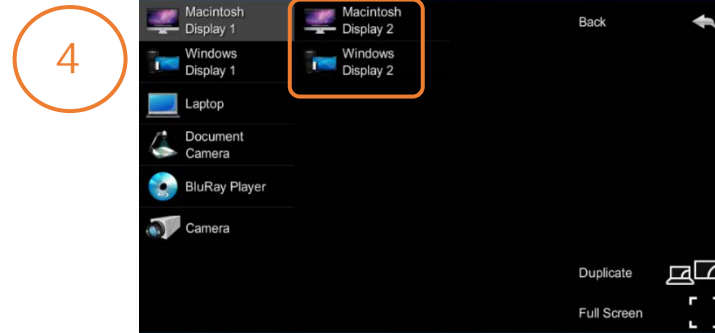
2. Touch Macintosh or Windows (whichever or both for the second display).



3. Then Extend.



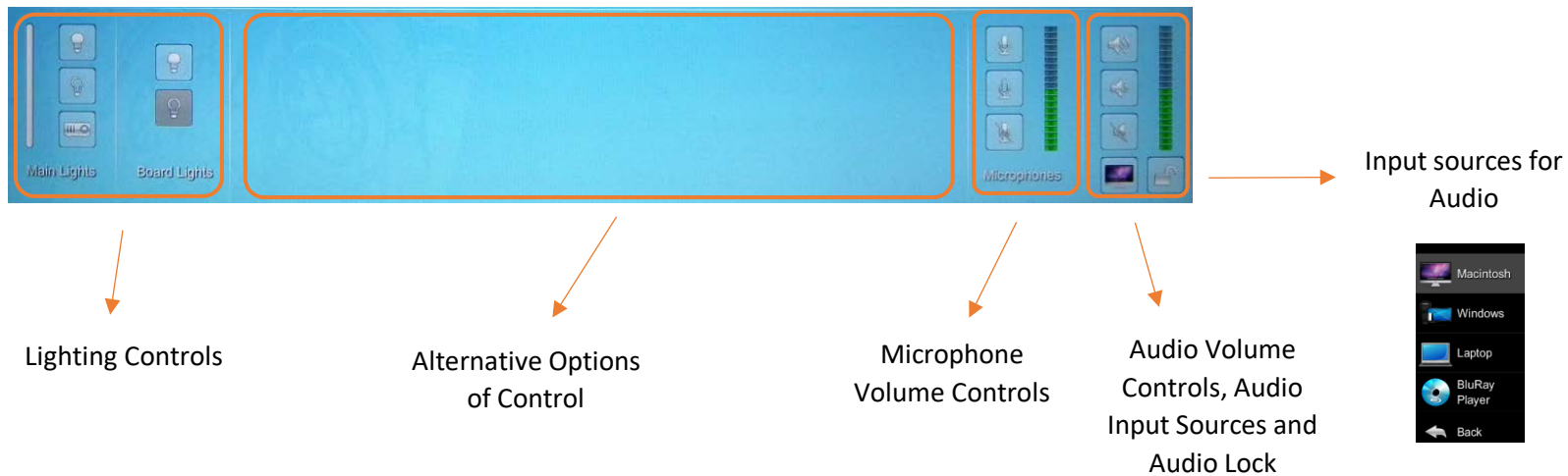
4. Then choose Display 2.



5. To remove second display, touch Input then touch Duplicate.



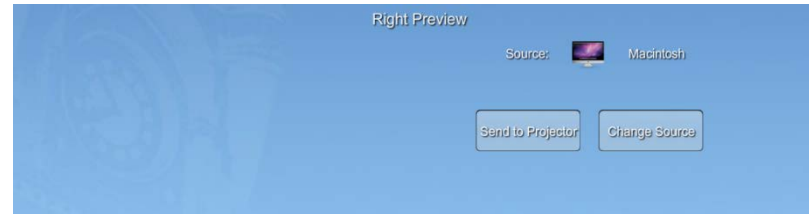
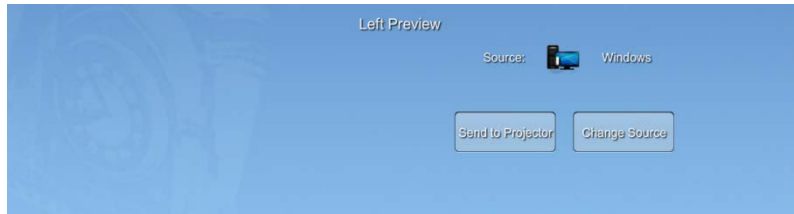

Alternative Options of Control (Window between Lights and Microphone Control)

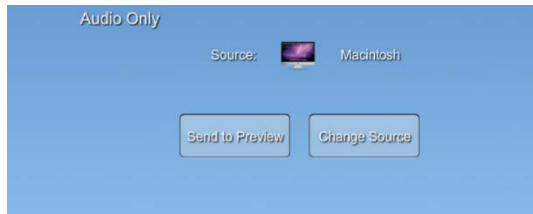

When you touch within the Preview screens these options come up in the Window:



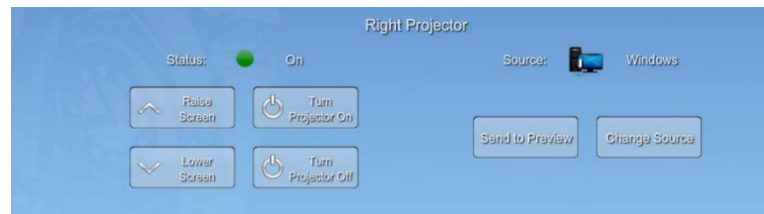
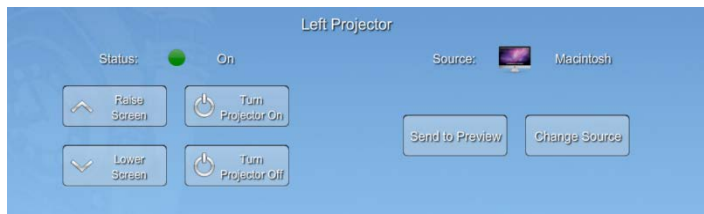

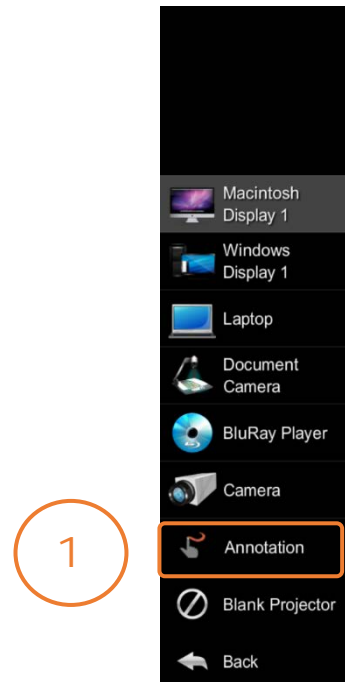


Input sources for Projectors when both computers are in Extend Mode

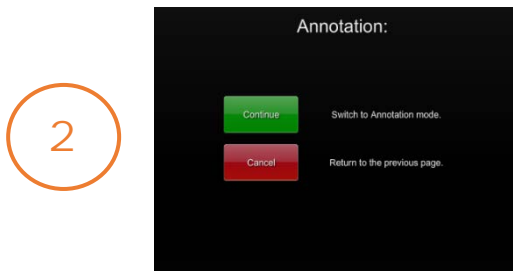


Annotation

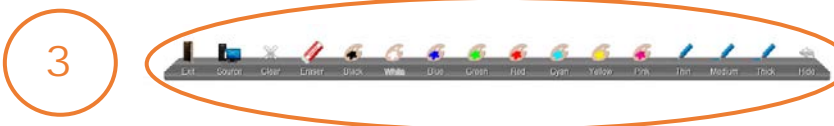
1. Touch Projector input source button and choose Annotation
