## New Zealand's Contributions to the Global Geodesy Supply Chain

The Global Geodesy Supply Chain (GGSC) describes the systems, organisations, infrastructure and knowledge underpinning global positioning, navigation, and timing (PNT). New Zealand is a strong contributor to the GGSC through its geodetic infrastructure, providing critical coverage from and for our part of the world. After describing the GGSC, and how New Zealand contributes, this presentation will discuss the challenges of sustaining aging infrastructure and the importance of building wider awareness of the critical links between geodesy, PNT and downstream services, from autonomous navigation systems to financial transactions.
