How to connect to the eduroam Wi-Fi service at another location using Android 4.x or higher

These instructions will help University of Otago staff and students connect to the eduroam wireless (Wi-Fi) service at participating locations. The default eduroam WLAN settings for your laptop are:

Please follow the steps below to configure your Android device to use the eduroam Wi-Fi service.

- Once you are at the eduroam-participating campus, select Settings > Wireless and network > Wi-Fi settings and find the eduroam wireless network.
- 2. Select **eduroam**. Enter the following settings using the drop-down boxes in the eduroam window:
 - EAP method: PEAP
 - Phase 2 authentication: MSCHAPV2
 - Identity: your University of Otago username (in the format <username>@otago.ac.nz)
 - **Password**: your associated University password.

Click Connect.

3. You are now connected to the eduroam network. Click on **eduroam** to verify your status.

Open your web browser and go to <u>http://www.otago.ac.nz</u> to confirm that you are connected to the eduroam network.
