

How to connect to the eduroam Wi-Fi service at another location using Android 4.x or higher

These instructions will help University of Otago staff and students connect to the eduroam wireless (Wi-Fi) service at participating locations. The default eduroam WLAN settings for your laptop are:

Eduroam Wi-Fi Security Configuration	
SSID	eduroam
Security	WPA2-Enterprise (802.1X/EAP)
Authentication Method	PEAP-MSCHAPv2
Encryption Type	AES-CCMP
Login User Account	<university username>@otago.ac.nz
Validate Server Certificate	AddTrust External CA Root OR AusCERTServerCA.crt

The Trusted Root CA certificate can be downloaded here if required:

Select: QuoVadis Root CA2
 SHA1 - RSA - 4096
 Download as DER

Please follow the steps below to configure your Android device to use the eduroam Wi-Fi service.

- Once you are at the eduroam-participating campus, select **Settings > Wireless and network > Wi-Fi settings** and find the **eduroam** wireless network.
- Select **eduroam**. Enter the following settings using the drop-down boxes in the eduroam window:
 - EAP method:** PEAP
 - Phase 2 authentication:** MSCHAPV2
 - Identity:** your University of Otago username (in the format <username>@otago.ac.nz)
 - Password:** your associated University password.

Click **Connect**.

- You are now connected to the eduroam network. Click on **eduroam** to verify your status.

Open your web browser and go to <http://www.otago.ac.nz> to confirm that you are connected to the eduroam network.
