### **Brief Introduction to the Paper**

This paper is designed to give students a basic knowledge of New Testament Greek, enabling them to use dictionaries and commentaries, and read simple texts. No prior knowledge of Greek is assumed. The course is taught both on campus and by Distance Learning.

### **Assessment**

This paper has internal assessment and a final exam.

- Assignments. 4 assignments worth a total of 20%
- Tests: 2 tests worth a total of 30%
- Final exam: 50%

### **Teaching schedule**

The **campus and distance class** will be taught together through 3 x 1 hr classes each week. Classes are recorded and made available to students.
