	Did I consider whether there is an alternative word or concept that I could use in my search? (Sometimes there is an index entry in the textbook or course workbook that refers to a 'higher' concept, or an entry that refers to more detail)
	Did I use a search engine (e.g. Google) to lead me to webpages that could put me on the right track?
	Did I check out different web pages? (Often there are links to other similar pages)

	Did I use the 'discussion board' on Blackboard to post my question?
	Did I bring up the questions during a tutorial or laboratory? .
	Did I access the teaching fellow/tutors/lecturers in my course who are available to discuss issues? (During office hours, or by appointment)
