

Pilot Guidelines: Second-Round Research Funding 2024/2025

Background

The Humanities Divisional Leadership Group has approved a pilot trial of use of humanities research funding to support researchers reaching the second round of major external funding rounds.

Eligibility

- ✚ Staff in the Division of Humanities
- ✚ Primary Investigator on a proposal
- ✚ Reaching the second round of MBIE, Marsden or TLRI funding.

Amount

- ✚ Full Marsden proposals, MBIE proposals, TLRI proposals – up to \$5000.
- ✚ Marsden Fast-Start proposals – up to \$2500.

Use

To support costs of preparing a full proposal. For example:

- travel/accommodation to meet collaborators,
- attending or organising hui with research partners,
- hiring an editor and/or professional grant-writer,
- buying in support for marking or teaching (with approval of HOS),
- Other costs associated with the development of the full proposal.

Process

- ✚ Pl's of successfully advancing proposals are notified by the Associate Dean Research – Humanities
- ✚ Pls submit a very brief budget to the Associate Dean Research – Humanities for approval
- ✚ Divisional Finance Manager opens an S-Account with the approved amount
- ✚ Funds must be expended by December 31st of the year it is awarded.
