# Setting up Macrons on Windows 7

Before you set this up, check which version of Windows you are using, as these instructions for Windows 7 are slightly different than the ones for Windows 10. Windows 10 will be covered next month.

Look in the bottom left corner of your monitor and check which of these start button symbols you see. For these instructions, it should be the symbol on the left.

Windows 10






## Change keyboard

Press the **Start** Button. In the Search box, type "change keyboards".

Select Change keyboards or other input methods from the list.



Then click on **Change keyboards** in the **Keyboards and Languages** tab of the **Region and Language** window.



### **Setting up Macrons on Windows 7 (continued)**

In the next window, it should show the **General** tab, with your current language and keyboard. Select the keyboard language and then press **Add**.




Find **English (New Zealand)** in the next window and under **Keyboard**, press **Show More**.



Scroll up to find **Māori**. Select it and click **OK**.

Click **OK** to close that window.

Then click on **OK** in the **Region and Language** window to close that one as well.



## Keyboard selector

In the bottom right corner of your screen you should see a small keyboard. Click on it to select the **Māori** option.

**NOTE**: You may need to reset this after restarting your computer or changing to a different application.



### Apply macrons as you type

When you come to a vowel requiring a macron, press the accent key in the top left the keyboard. (This usually has two symbols on it: ` and ~):

Then type the vowel. So ` and then "a" would give you: **ā**.

**Ā** would appear if you pressed the **Shift** key before typing "a".
