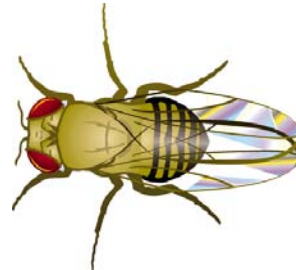
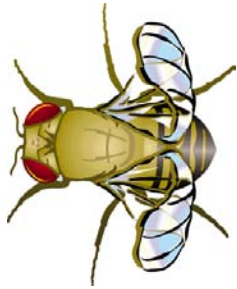


***Drosophila melanogaster*- What do they look like?**

Drosophila has many different mutant phenotypes. In this activity you will be given a variety of mutants to observe and draw their different phenotypes.



1. Before this activity your teacher will select and anaesthetised/ethanized 4 different mutant flies.
2. Collect about 20 flies and sort them (using a paint brush) into groups according to their phenotype. Use a microscope or hand lens to do this.
