

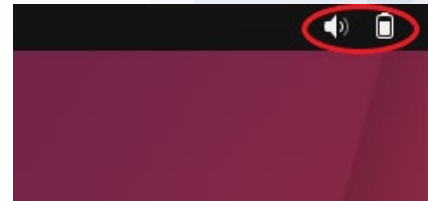
## Connecting to UO\_WIFI: Linux (Ubuntu 22.04)

### What is UO\_WIFI?

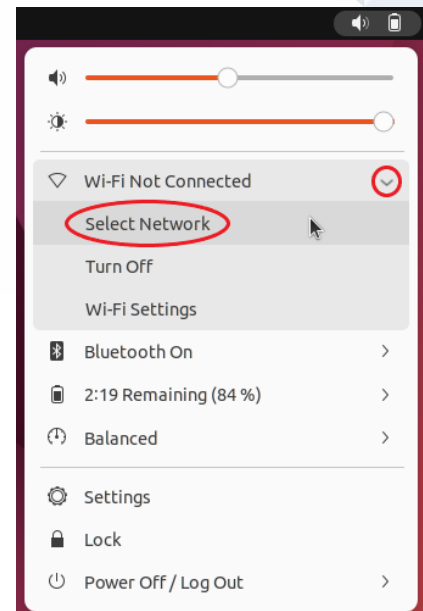
UO\_WIFI is the wireless network available to staff, students, and contractors to use when on University of Otago Sites. Those with laptops and wireless capable devices can connect to UO\_WIFI to access both internal University resources and the internet. Your level of access is determined from your username

### Connecting to UO\_WIFI

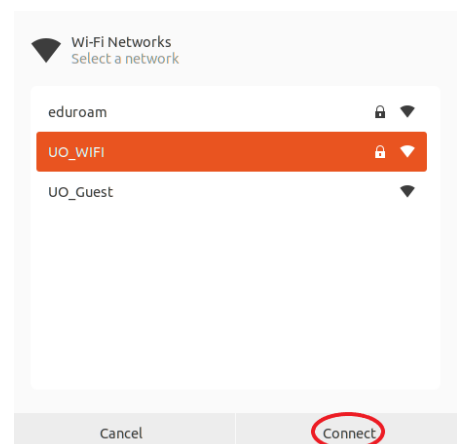
1. Click on the **system tray** in the top right corner.




2. Select **Wi-Fi Not Connected** then click on **Select Network**.



3. Select **UO\_WIFI** then click on **Connect**.



4. In the **Wi-Fi Network Authentication Required** window check that:  
 Wi-Fi Security: **WPA & WPA2 Enterprise**  
 Authentication: **Protected EAP (PEAP)**  
 Tick the box for **No CA certificate is required**  
 PEAP version: **Automatic**  
 Inner authentication: **MSCHAPv2**
5. Enter your University of Otago username and password. Click **Connect**.
