

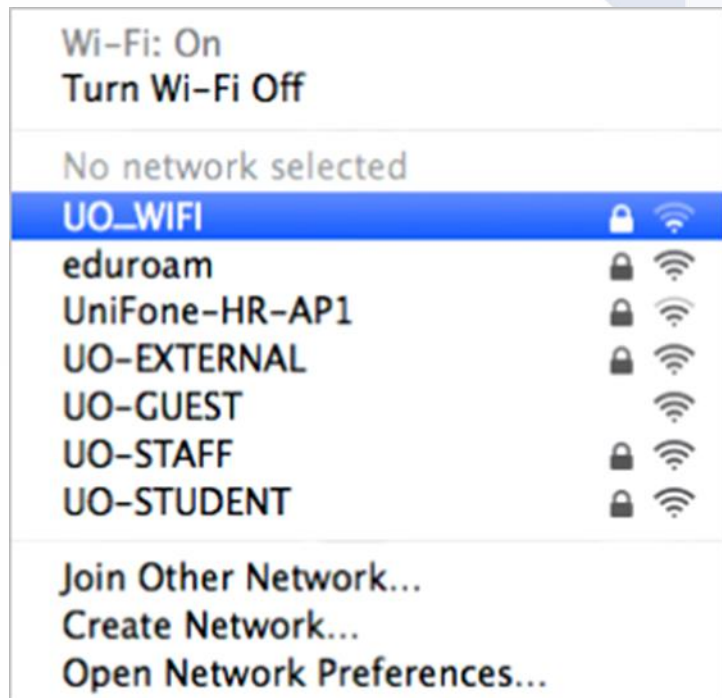
## Connecting to UO\_WIFI: Mac OS X

### What is UO\_WIFI?

The University of Otago network is being upgraded, and UO\_WIFI is the name of the new wireless network. The older networks (e.g., UO-STUDENT, UO-STAFF) will remain while the new network is being rolled out. Your device will switch between them if it has connected in the past.

### Connecting to UO\_WIFI

1. Click the Wi-Fi symbol by the clock on your Menu bar.
2. Check that the Wi-Fi is turned on and then select the University network **UO\_WIFI**.



3. Enter your University username and password and click Join.



4. If you are asked to Verify Certificate, click **Continue**. Enter your computer's password if you are prompted for it.



You are now connected.
