

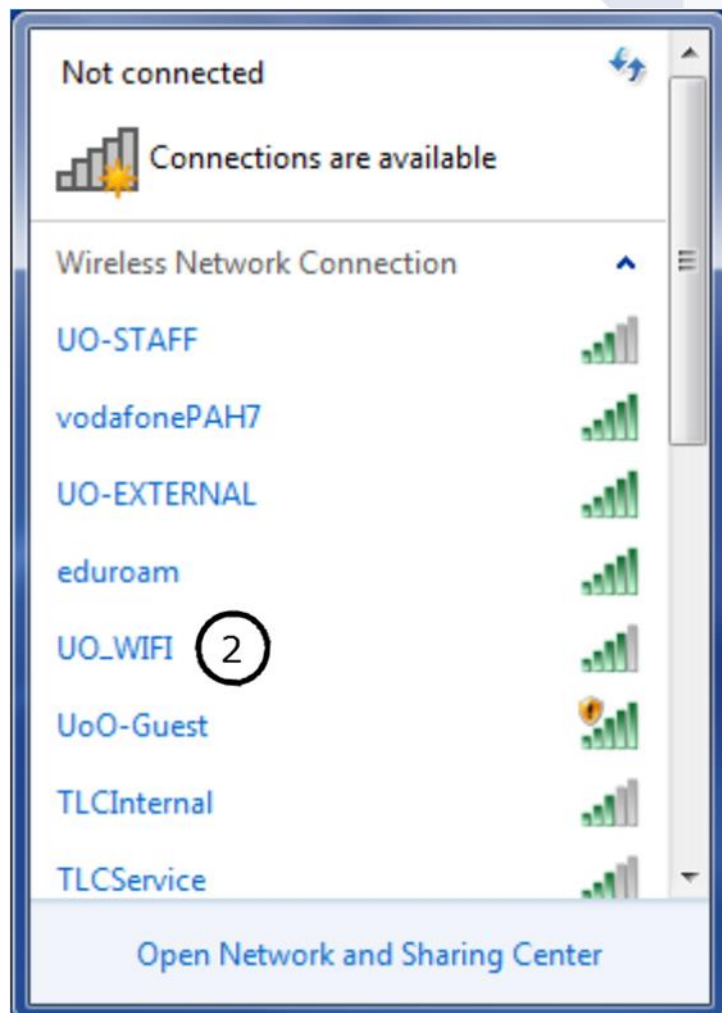
Connecting to UO_WIFI: Windows 7

What is UO_WIFI?

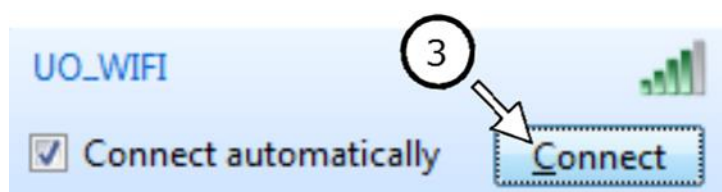
The University of Otago network is being upgraded, and UO_WIFI is the name of the new wireless network. The older networks (e.g., UO-STUDENT, UO-STAFF) will remain while the new network is being rolled out. Your device will switch between them if it has connected in the past.

Connecting to UO_WIFI

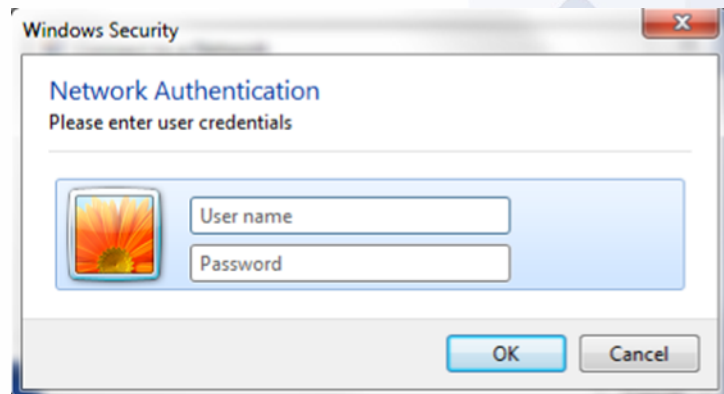
1. Click the Wireless Network symbol by the clock on your Start bar.
2. Select the University network UO_WIFI.



3. Click Connect.



4. Enter your **University username and password** in the Authentication window. Press **OK**.



5. If you are asked whether to Connect or Terminate, choose **Connect**.



6. You are now connected.
