

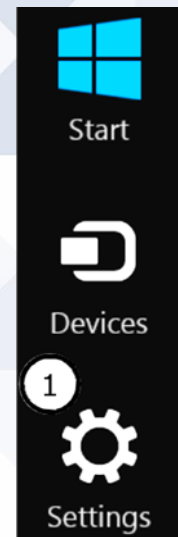
## Connecting to UO\_WIFI: Windows 8

### What is UO\_WIFI?

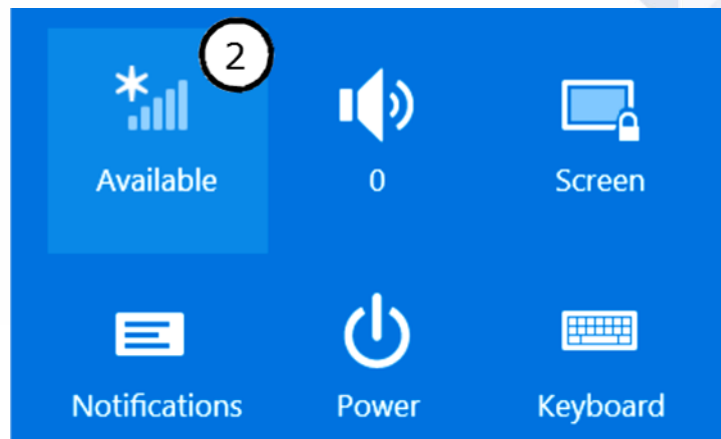
The University of Otago network is being upgraded, and UO\_WIFI is the name of the new wireless network. The older networks (e.g., UO-STUDENT, UO-STAFF) will remain while the new network is being rolled out. Your device will switch between them if it has connected in the past.

### Connecting to UO\_WIFI

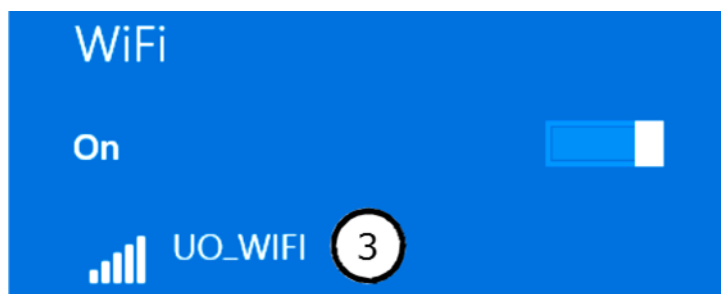
1. Open the **Charms menu** by swiping in from the right-hand edge of the screen, or moving the mouse to the right-hand corner of the screen. Choose **Settings**.



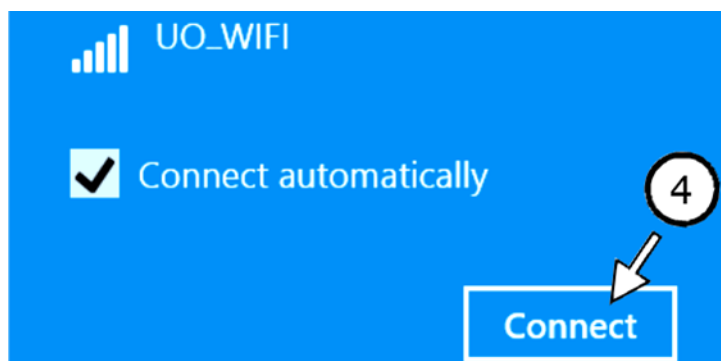
2. Select the **Wi-Fi** symbol.




3. Select the University network **UO\_WIFI**.




4. Press **Connect**.



5. Enter your **University username and password** in the Authentication window. Press **OK**.



6. If you are asked whether to Connect or Don't Connect, choose **Connect**.
