

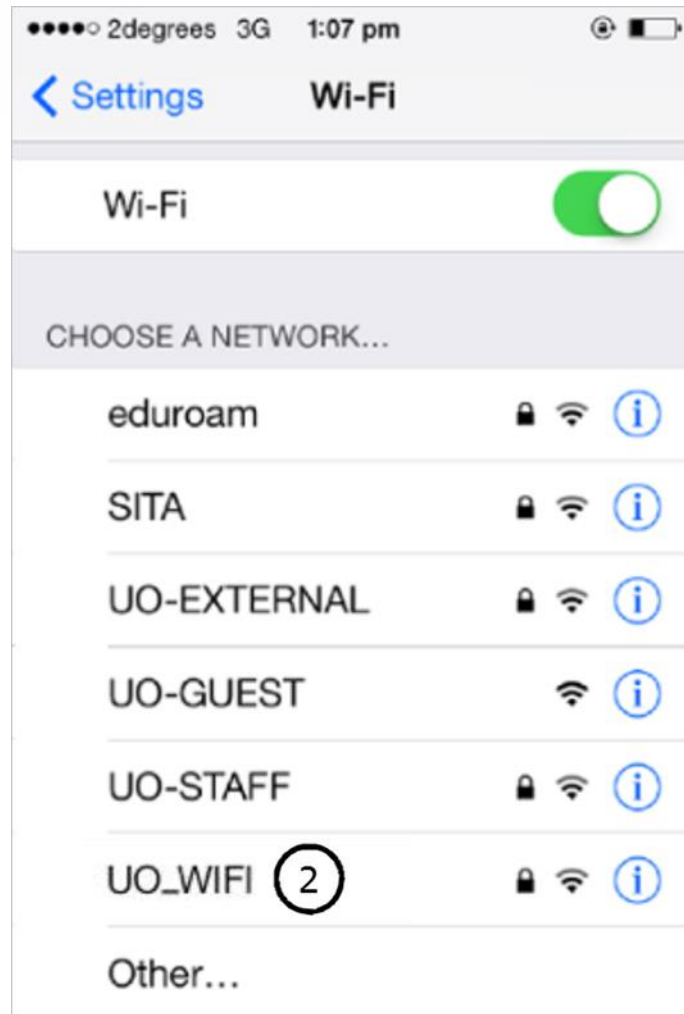
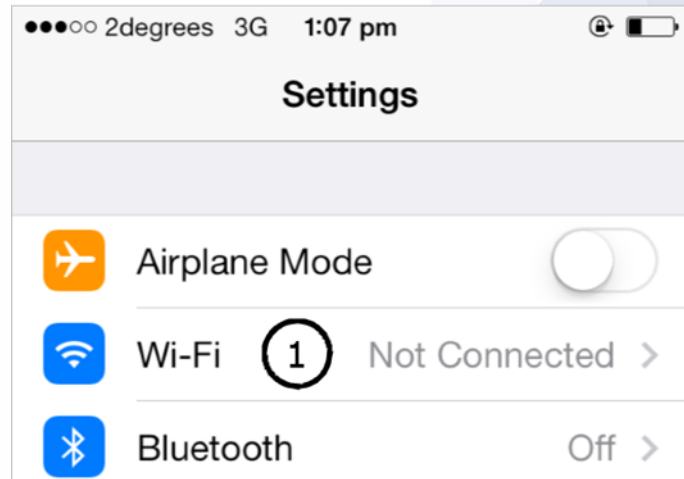
## Connecting to UO\_WIFI: iOS

### What is UO\_WIFI?

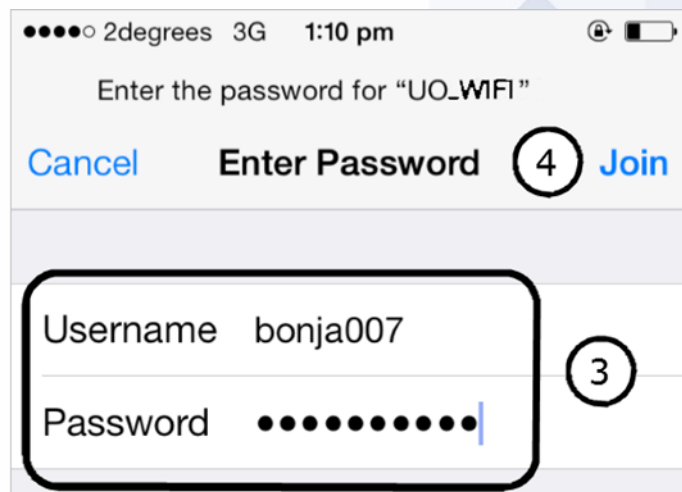
The University of Otago network is being upgraded, and UO\_WIFI is the name of the new wireless network. The older networks (e.g., UO-STUDENT, UO-STAFF) will remain while the new network is being rolled out. Your device will switch between them if it has connected in the past.

### Connecting to UO\_WIFI

1. Go to the **Settings** menu and select **Wi-Fi**.
2. Check that the wireless is turned on, and then select the University network **UO\_WIFI**.



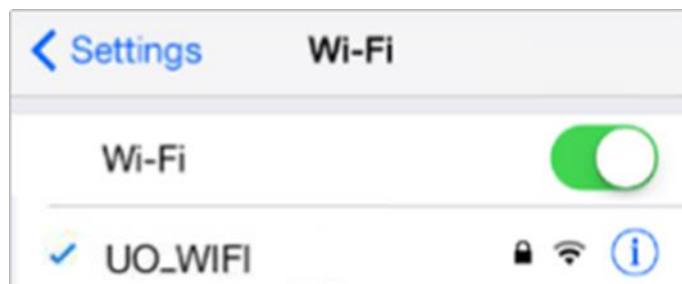
3. Enter your University username and password and tap Join.



4. Depending on your iOS version, tap Accept or Trust.



5. You are now connected.
