Here's a complete list of configuration actions performed when a computer is enrolled in Jamf (as at April 2021):

default-loginscreen profile

- Change login window to show user and password fields instead of user icons
- Sets the University of Otago blurb below the login fields University of Otago
 If you have problems logging in please contact AskOtago on 0800 80 80 98 or email university@otago.ac.nz.

default-configuration profile

- Delay software updates by 7 days
- Install default fonts

configure-uowifi profile

• Configures UO_WIFI

configure-apps-access profile

- Allows access for apps to system or other apps they need access to:
 - o Outlook Otago setup access to control Outlook and System Events
 - o Endnote and Zotero access to control Word
 - o Jamf access to control Adobe Digital Editions
 - o Zoom access to control computer
 - VirtualBox access to control computer
 - VLC access to control computer
 - o Sophos Endpoint to access all files
 - Parallels Desktop, FluxCenter to access user files
 - o LogMeIn Rescue to connect techs to provide support
 - Allows notifications for:
 - o Jamf
 - o Office apps
 - o Sophos
 - o Cisco Anyconnect VPN
 - o Citrix Viewer
 - InformaCast desktop notifier
 - o LogMeIn Rescue
 - o Zoom
- Auto-approves kernel/system extensions for:
 - o Elgato docks
 - o Citrix
 - Cisco AnyConnect VPN
 - Sophos
 - Syncplicity
 - Parallels
 - VirtualBox
 - o VMWare

configure-block-icloud-documents profile

Blocks users from being able to sync Documents/Desktop folders with iCloud
NOTE: Doesn't apply to computers with iCloud Documents/Desktop sync turned on at time of Jamf enrolment

Exemptions:

- Computers that already have iCloud document sync turned on
- Computers that have been granted an exemption for this policy

configure-admin-itss policy

- Adds ITSS local admin user
- Enables access via SSH for the ITSS user only

configure-defaults policy

- Configures defaults
 - Desktop/Finder settings such as showing network drives on the desktop
 - o Installs utilities for managing system
 - desktoppr
 - dockutil
 - InputSourceSelector
 - Otago Outlook setup utility
 - Enable automatic system updates
 - Enable Fast User Switching
 - Show admin info in login window
 - Disable extra warning when connecting to network shares
 - \circ $\;$ Allow non-admin users to manage WiFi and printer settings
 - o Disable sending diagnostic and usage data to Apple
 - Energy settings (sleep after 20 minutes on battery power, never when on charge)
 - University of Otago webpage as the home page on all browsers (for new user accounts only)
 - \circ ~ Set region to NZ and make sure Māori keyboard layout is available
 - o Installs a trigger to enable Jamf to trigger an immediate policy refresh
 - o Enables Screen Sharing access for ITSS user only
 - Installs an Institutional FileVault key so ITSS can unlock FileVault disks without needing the user's password (doesn't enable FileVault, only kicks in if the user enables it)

configure-department policy

 Makes sure the department specified for the assigned user in AD exists in Jamf so the computer gets assigned to it

configure-firmwarepassword policy

• Sets a firmware password so by default computers cannot be started up from external disks, put into Target Disk Mode or restored to factory settings

Exemptions:

• Computers that have been granted an exemption for this policy

configure-netbiosd-disable policy

 'netbiosd' is unnecessary, uses considerable processing resource, and is probably a bit too 'chatty' for the University network

configure-printers-CH policy

• Installs UO Print queue for Christchurch uniFLOW printers

configure-printers-DN policy

• Installs UO Print queue for Dunedin uniFLOW printers

configure-printers-WN policy

• Installs UO Print queue for Wellington uniFLOW printers

configure-user policy

- Removes Maps, Books, Photos, Siri from dock
- Adds Powerpoint, Excel, Word, Outlook, Firefox, Chrome, Safari, Software Centre and Downloads folder to dock
- Sets default home page to https://www.otago.ac.nz/

domain-registry policy

• Binds to the REGISTRY domain so users can log in using their staff/external usernames

install-auto policies

Policies that auto install the default applications. In general apps are only installed if they are not found already on the computer.
